

# Indianer Head Band

## Materials:

TLC® “Cotton Plus™”, Art. E516, 3 oz/85g; 155 yd/140m, 1 skein 3324 Thistle

**Crochet Hook:** 5 mm [US H-8].

Yarn needle.

**Gauge in pattern:** 11 sts = 2"; 4 rows = appr. 2.25"

**Measurements:** 2" wide, appr. 18-20" around (optional)

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Chain 11

**Row 1:** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, \*1 ch, sk 1 st, dc in next st\*, rep from \*to\* 2 more times, dc in last stitch, turn – 11 sts

**Row 2:** 3 ch, dc in next dc, \*1 ch, sk 1 st, dc in next dc\*, rep from \*to\* 2 more times, dc in last dc, turn – 11 sts

Rep Row 2 until piece meas appr. 18-20" from beginning.

**Finishing:** Crochet or sew ends together, fasten off.

**Fringes** – using 2 strands of yarn:

With left side facing, join yarn with sl st in any edge dc and work chain appr. 6 to 8" long, fasten off. Weave the fringe on right side through other edge (see picture).

Then work 3 more fringes beside last worked fringe.



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
